The parade ends with a fireworks show where Santa Claus will count down with all the parade goers and kick-off the beginning of the holidays in Buda, Texas! The parade takes place **Saturday, Dec 1 at 6:30 p.m.** and will travel down Main Street from **Buda Mill and Grain Co.** to Buda City Park.

Reindog Parade: Dogs from all around will gather to trot down the street in their best holiday costumes and outfits. The petparent of the most festive dog will win a prize! The Reindog Parade will take place on **Sunday, Dec. 2 at 2:00 PM** to kick-off the festivities.

Craft Vendors: Craft vendors from all across Texas will display their merchandise and hand-made wares for you to explore and discover the perfect unique gift for your loved ones this holiday season.
