**BUDA CITY FACILITIES OPEN FOR PUBLIC ACCESS THREE DAYS A WEEK  
(TUESDAY, WEDNESDAY, AND THURSDAY)  
CITY WILL CONDUCT BUSINESS VIRTUALLY ON MONDAY AND FRIDAY**

Due to the rise of active COVID-19 cases in Hays County, the City of Buda is adjusting its operating procedures. Starting Monday, June 29, Buda City facilities will be conducting business virtually on Monday and Friday until further notice. This means there will be no walk-ins, with all business being done via telephone and computer. City facilities will be open for public access on Tuesday, Wednesday, and Thursday. The City of Buda will continue to monitor this evolving situation and make further adjustments if needed.
