The City of Buda is pleased to announce Blake Neffendorf as our new Water Resources Coordinator. Neffendorf comes to Buda with over 10 years of experience.

Prior to working in Buda, Neffendorf spent 10 years with the Texas Development Board where he worked in the Groundwater Division as a Program Supervisor. In that role he managed a near real-time network of groundwater wells equipped with instrumentation to track changes in water-levels throughout many of the state's aquifers. Neffendorf has also worked for the Hays Trinity Groundwater Conservation District.
