


# TRAFFIC INFORMATION SHEET FOR BES 2019 START OF SCHOOL

Welcome Back Bulldogs! We're thrilled to open the doors on our new location this school year. We hope you had a wonderful summer filled with plenty of smiles and sunshine! Our new school is at: **1060 Old San Antonio Rd., Buda, TX 78610.**

As we welcome you back we have some very important information regarding our "Meet-the-Teacher" event on Tuesday, August 13th and the first few days of school, August 15th and 16th respectively.



The road construction on Old San Antonio Road will impact the traffic flow patterns and our parking. So, for safety and security, we have some temporary adjustments in place. We have consulted with the City of Buda; County Commissioner Mark Jones; district personnel, including our new safety director; as well as local law enforcement; and have determined the best plan. We greatly appreciate your patience and understanding regarding these temporary, but necessary, adjustments.

## >> Meet-the-Teacher, August 13<sup>th</sup> 6:00 p.m. – 7:00 p.m. (Campus Accessible by Shuttle Bus Only)

We hope you plan to attend! Please know that there will be no parking available at the campus. All parents and students must take a shuttle from the nearby Cabela's parking lot. Hays CISD buses will shuttle students and parents to our new campus, beginning at approximately 5:00 p.m., and running continuously through 6:15 p.m. The buses will drop parents and students off at the campus café, where the evening will begin. At 5:55 p.m., we will make an announcement for parents and students to make their way from the café to their teachers' classrooms. The last bus will leave the campus back to Cabela's at 7:10 p.m.

To help with the shuttle bus process for this night, please don't bring school supplies for Meet-the-Teacher. Instead, hang on to them until the first day of school.

## >> First Two Days of School August 15<sup>th</sup> & 16<sup>th</sup> (Staggered Start Times to Ease Traffic)

Due to the one way only (north bound) traffic on Old San Antonio Road; for the first two days of school, we are offering a staggered start time to help ease traffic congestion.

School will open at the normal time for anyone who rides the bus. Buses will not run on a delayed schedule. We strongly encourage you to send your child on the bus, if possible.

Parents who wish to park and go into the classroom with their children may do so, by grade level, according to the staggered start schedule (see chart below). Parents who do not plan to park and go into the building may drop off their children, regardless of grade-level, as early as 7:30 a.m. We will not count students tardy through the first full week of school, as we know traffic is typically heavy at the beginning of a school year, even under normal road conditions.
