## **City of Buda Lifts Stage 1 Drought Restrictions**

BUDA, TEXAS — Effective Friday, July 9, the City of Buda is lifting Stage 1 drought restrictions. This change has been initiated because of continued rainfall and the removal of Stage 2 pumping restrictions from Barton Springs Edwards Aquifer Conservation District.

Year-round conservation measures are in effect and city officials encourage area residents to continue to use water wisely. Irrigation with hose-end and automatic sprinkler systems is not allowed between the hours of 10 a.m. and 7 p.m. Residents may water on any day of the week, but are encouraged to voluntarily abide by the twice-per-week watering schedule.
